and Northern Ireland: revised draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 40/152 K, adopted by consensus on 16 December 1985,

Noting the related discussions that have taken place in the
Secretary-General's Advisory Board on Disarmament Studies during 1986,

1. Reaffirms the value of United Nations disarmament studies, and of the
need for a thorough appraisal of the subject;

2. Takes note with appreciation of the views of Member States contained in
the report of the Secretary-General; 1/

3. Invites those Member States that have not yet done so to communicate to
the Secretary-General, by 1 April 1987, their views and proposals on how the work
of the United Nations in the field of disarmament studies can be further improved;

4. Requests the Secretary-General to transmit the replies received in 1987
to the Advisory Board on Disarmament Studies and to the General Assembly at its
forty-second session;

5. Decides to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-second session
the item entitled "United Nations disarmament studies".
