Letter dated 10 November 1986 from the Chairman of the Fifth
Committee addressed to the Chairman of the First Committee

By its resolution 36/228 A, section I, the General Assembly endorsed the conclusions and recommendations of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (CPC) on the work of its twenty-first session (A/36/38, chap. VII). One of such recommendations is contained in paragraph 471 of the CPC report, which states that:

"Each chapter of the proposed medium-term plan should be submitted to the appropriate Main Committee of the General Assembly before the plan as a whole is adopted by the Assembly in plenary meeting."

At its current session, the General Assembly has before it, in document A/41/6 and Add.1, proposed revisions to the medium-term plan for the period 1984-1989.

The annex to this letter indicates, for each chapter of the proposed revisions the relevant Main Committee. In order to permit the Fifth Committee to take fully into account the views which the other Main Committees may wish to express, it would be appreciated if such views were to be communicated to the Fifth Committee no later than 19 November 1986.
