Letter dated 8 December 1986 from the Permanent Representative of
Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 2 December 1986 (A/41/955-S/18503), I have the honour to report to you a serious incident in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 4 December 1986. On that date, between 0900 hours and 0930 hours (Pakistan standard time), the Afghan armed forces fired seven tank rounds, which landed in the area approximately 3 kilometres north-west of Landi Kotal in the Khyber Agency, as a result of which six persons were injured.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office in Islamabad on 7 December 1986, and a strong protest was lodged with him over this unprovoked attack.
