REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Report of the Second Committee (Part I)\*

Rapporteur: Mr. Boris GOUDIMA (Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic)

1. At its 3rd planary meeting, on 20 September 1986, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in its agenda the item entitled:

"Report of the Economic and Social Council:
