1. The Permanent Mission of Turkey to the United Nations ... has the honour to convey supplementary information under agenda item 128 in connection with the information contained in the report of the Secretary-General submitted to the fortieth session of the General Assembly (A/40/453) relating to the assassination of Mr. Zaid I. Sati, First Secretary of the Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, at Ankara on 24 July 1985. As a result of the investigation carried out with regard to the assassination of Mr. Sati, the following individuals were arrested by the Turkish security authorities on 13 October 1986: Sami Rashdi Ahmet Washan (citizen of Israel); Nader Hossanien Habroush (citizen of Israel); Bassem Lutfi Fayas Said El Ahmed (citizen of Jordan); Naif Mousa Khamris al Nadi (citizen of Jordan).
2. Preliminary investigations are being conducted by the State Security Court and the trial of the said individuals will take place shortly.
3. It was also ascertained that two more suspects were in a foreign country and steps have been taken for their extradition to Turkey.
