NOTE VERBALE DATED 29 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF SINGAPORE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Republic of Singapore to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to his note SCPC/7/91/4-1 of 3 July 1991, has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the Republic of Singapore, in full conformity with the spirit and letter of Security Council resolution 700 (1991), strictly abides by the prohibitions against the sale or supply of arms to Iraq. The Republic of Singapore has imposed comprehensive economic sanctions on Iraq since August 1990 via the Prohibition of Imports and Exports (Iraq) Order 1990 which prohibits the imports and exports of all goods, including arms, from and to Iraq. Singapore continues to strictly enforce these sanctions.
