NOTE VERBALE DATED 29 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF
CHILE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note SCPC/7/91(4-1) of 2 July, relating to Security Council resolution 700 (1991), which reiterates "the prohibitions against the sale or supply of arms to Iraq and related sanctions established in paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991)".

In this connection, the Permanent Mission of Chile informs the Secretary-General that the Government of Chile is maintaining in force Supreme Foreign Affairs Decrees No. 808 of 8 August 1990, which orders full compliance with Security Council resolution 661 (1990) imposing sanctions on the Republic of Iraq, and No. 1139 of 30 October 1990, ordering compliance with Security Council resolution 670 (1990) which supplements resolution 661 (1990).
