NOTE VERBALE DATED 30 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF MYANMAR TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Union of Myanmar to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and in reply to the Secretary-General's note dated 3 July 1991 requesting information, in pursuance of paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 700 (1991), on the measures instituted by the Government of Myanmar for meeting the obligations set out in paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991), has the honour to state as follows:

Following the adoption by the Security Council of resolution 661 (1990), the Government of Myanmar on 15 August 1990 decided to take necessary measures for the full implementation of the provisions of the said resolution. To give effect to this decision the Ministry of Trade of the Government of Myanmar issued directives to all ministries and government departments concerned as well as to non-governmental organizations, private enterprises and Myanmar nationals prohibiting them from engaging in any trade directly or indirectly with Iraq.

In conjunction with the laws and regulations in force in the country those directives that the Myanmar Government is continuing to enforce fully meet the obligations set out in paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991) and will also enable the Myanmar authorities to act in a manner consistent with the relevant parts of the guidelines approved by the Security Council in resolution 700 (1991).
