NOTE VERBALE DATED 1 AUGUST 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to His Excellency's note of 3 July has the honour to inform him of the following.

By complying fully with the articles of Security Council resolution 661 (1990), the Yugoslav Government reached a decision on 9 August 1991 to implement strictly the sanctions contained therein. These sanctions include the cessation of arms and military equipment supplies to Iraq. This decision is still in force and encompasses the obligations under paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991). The decision of the Government of Yugoslavia will remain in effect until the Security Council sanctions against Iraq are abolished.
