LETTER DATED 31 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft continue to violate Iraqi airspace, as follows:

T

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 28/29 July 1991 amounted to 12 sorties flown by six two-aircraft formations at speeds of 600 to 900 kilometres per hour and at low and medium altitudes.
- 2. The hostile flights centred over Arbil, Dohuk, Zakho, Amadiyah and Tall Afar, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

II

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 29/30 July 1991 amounted to 21 sorties flown by 10 two-aircraft formations and one single aircraft at speeds of 600 to 900 kilometres and at various altitudes.
- 2. The hostile air activity centred over the areas of Mosul, Amadiyah, Dohuk, Arbil and to the north of Tall Afar, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
