LETTER DATED 18 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that the United States Air Force continues to violate Iraqi airspace. The most recent violations are as follows:

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 16/17 July 1991 amounted to 12 sorties flown by six two-aircraft formations. The enemy aircraft flew at speeds of 600 to 800 kilometres per hour at low and medium altitudes.
- 2. Air activity centred over Mosul, Dahuk and northern Arbil, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
