LETTER DATED 22 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft continue to violate Iraqi airspace, as follows:

1

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 17/18 July 1991 amounted to 18 sorties flown by five two-aircraft formations, one four-aircraft formation and four single aircraft at speeds of 600 to 720 kilometres per hour and at low and medium altitudes.
- 2. Enemy air activity centred over Mosul, Arbil and Dohuk, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

ΙI

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 18/19 July 1991 amounted to 25 sorties flown by 12 two-aircraft formations and one single aircraft at speeds of 700 to 900 kilometres per hour and at low and medium altitudes.
- 2. Air activity centred over Mosul, Arbil, Dohuk, Amadiyah and Tall 'Afar, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

III

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 19/20 July 1991 amounted to 16 sorties flown by eight two-aircraft formations at speeds of 600 to 700 kilometres per hour and at altitudes ranging from 4,000 to 5,000 metres.
- Flights centred over Mosul, Arbil and Dohuk, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

IV

1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 20/21 July 1991 amounted to six sorties flown by three two-aircraft formations at speeds of 600 to 720 kilometres per hour and at medium altitudes.

2. The American air activity centred over Dohuk and north-east of Mosul, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
