NOTE VERBALE DATED 1 AUGUST 1991 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF BRAZIL TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Acting Permanent Representative of Brazil to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to Note SCPC/7/91(4-1) of 3 July 1991, has the honour to inform that the Government of Brazil strictly abides by the prohibitions against the sale or supply of arms to Iraq, in conformity with the relevant resolutions of the Security Council.

The Government of Brazil has issued Decree No. 99441 of 7 August 1990 (document S/21476 of 9 August 1990) concerning mandatory compliance with resolution 661 (1990) and acts strictly in accordance with the provisions of subsequent resolutions on this subject, including in particular the obligations set out in paragraph 24 of resolution 667 (1991). Bearing in mind the guidelines approved by resolution 700 (1991), an interministerial commission is currently in charge of proposing adjustments to the existing national regulations on the export of arms and related matériel.
