Letter dated 25 July 1991 from the President of the Republic of the Marshall Islands addressed to the Secretary-General

On behalf of the Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands and in my capacity as its Chief of State and Government, I have the honour to make this application for membership in the United Nations.

I should accordingly be grateful if you would arrange for this application to be placed before the Security Council and the General Assembly at their next meetings.

To this end, a declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and rule 134 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly is set out hereunder.

DECLARATION

In connection with the application by the Republic of the Marshall Islands for membership in the United Nations, I have the honour, on behalf of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, and in my capacity as President, to declare that the Republic of the Marshall Islands accepts the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations and solemnly undertakes to fulfil them.
