On behalf of the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and in my capacity as President, I have the honour to inform you that the Federated States of Micronesia wishes herewith to make application for membership in the United Nations, with all the rights and duties attached thereto.

I would accordingly be grateful if you would arrange for this application to be placed before the Security Council and the General Assembly at their next meetings.

For this purpose, a declaration made pursuant to rule 58 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and rule 134 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly is set out hereunder.

Declaration

In connection with the application by the Federated States of Micronesia for membership in the United Nations, I have the honour on behalf of the Federated States of Micronesia and in my capacity as Head of State, to declare that the Federated States of Micronesia accepts the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations and solemnly undertakes to fulfil them.
