REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS CONCERNING
THE APPLICATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS FOR
ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

1. At the 3000th meeting on 6 August 1991, the Security Council had before it the application of the Republic of the Marshall Islands (S/22865) for admission to membership in the United Nations. In accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in the absence of a proposal to the contrary, the President of the Council referred the application to the Committee on the Admission of New Members for examination and report.
2. At its 76th meeting on 6 August 1991, the Committee considered the application of the Republic of the Marshall Islands and unanimously decided to recommend to the Security Council that it should be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
3. Accordingly, the Committee recommends to the Security Council the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The Security Council,

Having examined the application of the Republic of the Marshall Islands for admission to the United Nations, 1/

Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of the Marshall Islands be admitted to membership in the United Nations.
