Implementation of the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, by its resolution 45/158 of 18 December 1990, adopted and opened for signature, ratification and accession the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families and called upon all Member States to consider signing and ratifying or acceding to the Convention as a matter of priority.
- 2. By the same resolution, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its forty-sixth session a report on the status of the Convention.
- 3. As at 1 August 1991, the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families had received one signature, by Mexico. No ratifications of or accessions to this Convention had been received by or deposited with the Secretary-General.
