LETTER DATED 12 AUGUST 1991 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, and further to our previous letters concerning the latest Iraqi violations of the terms of the cease-fire, I have the honour to report five cases of such violations by Iraqi military from 22 to 27 July 1991.

- 1. On 22 July 1991, four Iraqi soldiers were observed planting mines at the geographic coordinates of N 29-82 on the map of Nahr-e-Anbar.
- 2. On 23 July 1991, at 1840 hours, 15 Iraqi soldiers carrying three rocket launchers were stationed at the geographic coordinates of N 536-446 on the map of Sumar.
- 3. On 24 July 1991, boxes of ammunition, being carried by an Iraqi IFA vehicle, were unloaded by Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of N 548- 21 on the map of Sumar.
- 4. On 26 July 1991, at 1905 hours, 15 Iraqi forces were stationed in new bunkers at the geographic coordinates of N 593-340 on the map of Kani-Sheikh.

5. On 27 July 1991, three Iraqi soldiers were observed patrolling at the geographic coordinates of N 56-40 on the map of Hoor.
