OF MEXICO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Mission of Mexico to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the latter's note SCPC/7/91 of 3 July 1991, concerning Security Council resolution 700 (1991), has the honour to communicate the following information:

The Government of Mexico, seeking to discharge fully its obligations under the terms of paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 687 (1991), has continued to implement scrupulously the measures adopted in accordance with Security Council resolution 661 (1991).

To this end, the Government of Mexico has maintained close communication and coordination between the Ministries of Foreign Affairs, Commerce, Transport and Communications, and Finance, as well as between other government offices, with a view to ensuring that the provisions of the Security Council resolutions are not violated.

Finally, it should also be noted in the context of paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991) that Mexico, in keeping with its traditional policy in support of general and complete disarmament, has no export weapons industry, nor does it promote or facilitate the sale or supply of arms or related matériel of any type. Likewise, Mexico neither promotes nor facilitates personnel or materials for training or technical support services relating to the design, development, manufacture, use, maintenance or support of any type of weapons or related materials.
