**NOTE VERBALE DATED 9 AUGUST 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF CYPRUS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Cyprus to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his Note No. SPC/7/91/(4-1) of 3 July 1991, has the honour to transmit the following information:

(a) The Government of the Republic of Cyprus fully implements all resolutions of the United Nations.

(b) In particular concerning Security Council resolutions 687 (1991) and 700 (1991) the Government prevents the sale or supply of arms and related material, or the promotion or facilitation of such sale or supply to Iraq by its nationals, or from its territory or using its flag vessels or aircraft as called for in paragraph 24 of resolution 687 (1991) and as set out in the guidelines of the Secretary-General approved by the Security Council in its resolution 700 (1991).

(c) Resolution 700 (1991) of the Security Council, and the report of the Secretary-General (S/22660) which contains the approved guidelines of the Secretary-General to facilitate full implementation of paragraphs 24, 25 and 27 of Security Council resolution 687 (1991) have been brought to the attention of the appropriate authorities of the Government of the Republic of Cyprus.
