## Corrigendum

The following correction has been requested by the Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations:

## Page 1, second paragraph, last two sentences should read:

"Some of the casualties of the Iraqi flagrant violations of the 1925 Geneva Protocol on the Prohibition of the Use in War of Asphyxiating, Poisonous and Other Gases have been hospitalized and accessible to visiting representatives of international organizations including the United Nations team of experts should the pertinent body of the United Nations, unlike the Secretary-General, require further proof of the Iraqi criminal use of chemical weapons in order to pronounce itself on the issue and adopt measures to uphold the authority of the international instrument in question."
