LETTER DATED 11 SEPTEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft are continuing their violations of Iraqi airspace, as follows:

- 1. United States air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 10/11 September 1991 amounted to 30 sorties flown by 14 two-aircraft formations and two single aircraft at speeds of 720 to 850 kilometres per hour and at altitudes of 1.5 to 17 kilometres.
- 2. Air activity was centred over Mosul, Arbil, Dohuk and the Faruk airfield and had the purpose of observation and provocation.
- 3. At 15.05 hours, three helicopters were sighted to the south of Dohuk.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
