LETTER DATED 26 SEPTEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft continue to violate Iraqi airspace, as follows:

- 1. On 24 and 25 September 1991 United States aircraft continued to violate Iraqi airspace for the purpose of observation and provocation; air activity amounted to 25 sorties flown by 10 two-aircraft formations and five single aircraft at speeds of 600 to 700 kilometres per hour and at altitudes of 5,000 to 18,000 metres.
- 2. Air activity centred over Dohuk, Arbil, Zakho, Mosul, Tall 'Afar, Rawanduz and Dukan.
- 3. At 1120 hours a two-aircraft (type F-15) formation overflew Tall 'Afar airport (Faruk) at an altitude of 100 metres and at a speed of 700 kilometres per hour.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
