

## Declaration on the installation of the President of Suriname, issued at The Hague on 13 September 1991 by the European Community

On the occasion of his installation as President of the Republic of Suriname, the European Community and its member States address to the President, Mr. Runaldo Ronald Venetiaan, their warmest congratulations on his election and their best wishes for his success in the important tasks which are now entrusted to him.

The European Community and its member States express the hope that Suriname, having demonstrated during the recent elections its attachment to democracy, will take the path to peace and development, in full respect of the principles of the rule of law. Suriname can now resume its place as a respected member of the international community. The European Community and its member States would like to take this opportunity to address to the Surinamese people a message of friendship and solidarity.
