Communiqué issued by the Government of Peru

The Government of Peru welcomes the reintegration of the Baltic Republics of Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania into the international community as independent nations through a process reflecting the deep and authentic national aspirations of their peoples.

In regaining their independence they have reaffirmed the principles of self-determination and non-intervention that govern the conduct of sovereign nations and foster their mutual understanding.

The Government of Peru takes pleasure in announcing that it will shortly establish diplomatic relations with the Baltic republics and will support their admission to the United Nations.
