LETTER DATED 18 SEPTEMBER 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft continue to violate Traqi airspace, as follows:

- 1. On 16/17 September 1991, United States air activity inside Iraqi airspace amounted to 29 sorties flown by 12 two-aircraft formations and five single aircraft at speeds of 720 to 1,100 kilometres per hour and at altitudes ranging between 4,000 and 18,000 metres.
- 2. Air activity was concentrated over the areas of Dohuk, Zakho, Arbil, Mosul, Tall Afar, Rawanduz, Dukan and Amadiyah, for purposes of observation and provocation.
- 3. At 1755 hours local time, a helicopter was detected flying north of the town of Dohuk at a speed of 240 kilometres per hour.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
