NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

- 1. At the 93rd plenary meeting of its forty-first session, on 2 December 1986, the General Assembly adopted resolution 41/43, entitled "Question of Palestine". $\underline{1}$ /
- 2. In paragraph 2 of resolution 41/43 A, the General Assembly:

"Endorses the recommendations of the Committee contained in paragraphs 112 to 120 of its report and draws the attention of the Security Council to the fact that action on the Committee's recommendations, as repeatedly endorsed by the General Assembly at its thirty-first session and subsequently, is still awaited;".

- 3. In paragraphs 3, 5 and 6 of resolution 41/43 D, the General Assembly:
 - "3. Reaffirms once again its endorsement of the call for convening the International Peace Conference on the Middle East in conformity with the provisions of the resolution 38/58 C;

"...

- "5. Endorses the call for setting up a preparatory committee, within the framework of the Security Council, with the participation of the permanent members of the Council, to take the necessary action to convene the Conference;
- "6. Requests the Secretary-General, in consultation with the Security Council, to continue his efforts with a view to convening the Conference and to report thereon to the General Assembly not later than 15 May 1987;".
