Situation of human rights in southern Lebanon

Note by the Secretary-General

1. By its decision 1991/268 of 31 May 1991, the Economic and Social Council took note of the report of the Commission on Human Rights, 1/ containing resolution 1991/66 of 6 March 1991 on the situation of human rights in southern Lebanon. In paragraph 5 of the resolution, the Commission requested the Secretary-General (a) to bring the resolution to the attention of the Government of Israel and to invite it to provide information concerning the extent of its implementation thereof and (b) to report to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session and to the Commission on Human Rights at its forty-eighth session on the results of his efforts in that regard.
2. In accordance with that request, the Secretary-General, on 27 June 1991, addressed a note verbale to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State of Israel, in which he drew the attention of the Minister for Foreign Affairs to paragraph 5 of the resolution.
