1. Mr. CUSANO (Uruguay) announced that an informal working group was to meet during the afternoon to prepare a revised version of the Uruguayan draft resolution (A/C.2/L.165 and Corr.1-3). The working group would take into consideration the various suggestions and objections that had been made during the discussion. He moved that the meeting should be adjourned in order to enable the working group to work out a text that could be circulated the following morning.

2. Mr. SALAMANCA FIGUEROA (Bolivia) supported the Uruguayan representative's motion.

3. The CHAIRMAN declared the list of speakers closed. It consisted of the representatives of the following countries: Turkey, Pakistan, Bolivia, New Zealand, Ecuador, Yugoslavia, Chile, Argentina, India, Czechoslovakia, Ethiopia, China, Australia, Iraq, Iran, Indonesia, France, Colombia, Peru, Guatemala, Liberia, Belgium, Brazil, Poland, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom, United States of America, Union of South Africa, Philippines, Netherlands, Mexico and Canada.

4. The Chairman put the Uruguayan motion to the vote.

The motion was adopted by 23 votes to none, with 21 abstentions.

The meeting rose at 3.55 p.m.
