- 1. Mr. BANNIER (Netherlands) said that negotiations were continuing between the two groups of delegations which had submitted draft resolutions on the establishment of a Special United Nations Fund for Economic Development. One or two important points remained to be settled, but a satisfactory solution would probably be found in the course of the afternoon. The draft would not be available for submission to the Committee until very late in the evening.
- 2. Mr. RAJAPATHIRANA (Ceylon), speaking as a sponsor of one of the drafts, confirmed Mr. Bannier's remarks.
- 3. The CHAIRMAN suggested that, in the circumstances, the Committee should adjourn and meet again the following day.
