ACTIVITIES IN THE FIELD OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT

CONFIRMATION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE UNITED NATIONS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Section II, paragraph 18, of General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI) of 18 November 1966 entitled "United Nations Industrial Development Organization" states:

"The secretariat shall be headed by the Executive Director, who shall be appointed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations and whose appointment shall be confirmed by the General Assembly. He shall be appointed for four years and shall be eligible for reappointment."

2. Accordingly, the Secretary-General proposes to appoint Mr. Ibrahim Helmi Abdel-Rahman as Executive Director of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization for a term of four years beginning on 1 January 1967, and expresses the hope that the General Assembly will confirm this appointment.
