APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY QUESTIONS

#### Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Brian J. LYNCH (New Zealand)

- 1. At its 1199th meeting, held on 13 November 1967, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/6681) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as a result of the expiration on 31 December 1967 of the terms of office of four of its members.
- 2. The members of the Committee were invited to suggest the names of persons who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the Advisory Committee in accordance with the provisions of rules 156 and 157 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly. Five names were submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
- 3. To decide on its recommendation the Committee voted by secret ballot. The result of the voting was as follows:

Number of valid ballots:	104
Abstentions:	0
Number of members voting:	104
Required majority:	53

### Number of votes obtained:

Mr. Dragos Serbanescu 81

Mr. E. Olu Sanu 77

Mr. Paulo Lopes Corrêa 75

Mr. Mohamed Riad 71

One other person received 61 votes.

4. Mr. Serbanescu (Romania), Mr. Sanu (Nigeria), Mr. Corrêa (Brazil) and Mr. Riad (United Arab Republic), having received the required majority, were declared recommended for appointment as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1968.

#### RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

#### The General Assembly

- 1. Appoints the following persons as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions:
  - Mr. Paulo Lopes Corrêa,
  - Mr. Mohamed Riad,
  - Mr. E. Olu Sanu.
  - Mr. Dragos Serbanescu;
- 2. <u>Declares Mr. Corrêa</u>, Mr. Riad, Mr. Sanu, and Mr. Serbanescu to be appointed for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1968.
