CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE TWENTY-SECOND SESSION
OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Third report of the Credentials Committee

Chairman: Mr. Cornelius C. CREMIN (Ireland)

1. The Credentials Committee held its third meeting on 23 September 1968. The representatives of the following Member States appointed to the Committee by the General Assembly participated in the meeting: Ceylon, Ireland, Japan, Madagascar, Mexico, Paraguay, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and United States of America.
2. The Chairman recalled that the Committee, at its second meeting, held on 11 June 1968, had decided to meet again at a later stage with a view to examining the outstanding credentials of some of the representatives to the resumed twenty-second session of the General Assembly and drew its attention to the memorandum of the Secretary-General of 23 September 1968 from which it appeared that credentials of all those representatives were now in order. He then proposed that the Committee should find the credentials of the representatives concerned in order and recommend to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution approving the Committee's report.
3. The Chairman's proposal was unanimously adopted.
