UNITED NATIONS INSTITUTE FOR TRAINING AND RESEARCH

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In resolution 2044 (XX) of 8 December 1965, the General Assembly requested the Executive Director of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research to "report annually to the General Assembly and, as appropriate, to the Economic and Social Council on the activities of the Institute".
2. The annual report of the Executive Director is now before the Assembly in document A/6875.
3. The Executive Director of the Institute presented a separate report to the Economic and Social Council at its forty-third session.<sup>1/</sup> In resolution 1249 (XLIII) of 27 July 1967, the Council took note of the report; noted with satisfaction the progress made by the Institute and welcomed particularly its activities in training and research directed towards assisting the developing countries and strengthening the capabilities and procedures of the United Nations; recognized the importance of the Institute's close collaboration with the United Nations Secretariat, with other United Nations bodies, and with the specialized agencies, as well as with appropriate national and international organizations; and expressed its appreciation to the Governments, private institutions and individuals that had already made or pledged financial contributions to the Institute. An account of the discussion in the Council may be found in the report of the Council to the General Assembly at its twenty-second session.<sup>2/</sup>
