Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 1224th meeting, held on 13 December 1967, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/6971), in which he informed the General Assembly that, with the concurrence of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, he had reappointed the present members of the Investments Committee to a further term of office ending on 31 December 1970.
