Report of the Fifth Committee

1. On 14 December 1967, at its 1225th meeting, the Fifth Committee considered a statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/1156) and an oral report by the Chairman of the Advisory Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee (A/6977), additional expenditures in a total amount of \$9,500 would arise in 1968. However, as the Secretary-General had advised that he would endeavour to meet these additional costs within the regular budgetary appropriations for 1968, the adoption of the draft resolution would require no additional appropriation for 1968.
