URGENT NEED FOR SUSPENSION OF NUCLEAR AND THERMONUCLEAR TESTS

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. In resolution 2828 A (XXVI) of 16 December 1971, the General Assembly, inter alia, reiterated solemnly and most emphatically its condemnation of all nuclear weapon tests and urged the Governments of nuclear-weapon States to bring to a halt all nuclear weapon tests at the earliest possible date and, in any case, not later than 5 August 1973. It further requested the Secretary-General to transmit the resolution to the nuclear-weapon States and to inform the General Assembly at its twenty-seventh session of any measures taken by them to implement it.
- 2. By letter to the five nuclear-weapon Powers, dated 8 February 1972, the Secretary-General transmitted the resolution and requested that he be informed in due time of any measure taken in this regard.
- 3. As of 15 September 1972, no replies to the letter of the Secretary-General had been received.
