THE SITUATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST

Letter dated 17 February 1971 from the Permanent Representative of Jordan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

My Government has received information that the Israeli authorities have bulldozed parts of the premises of Government House, the headquarters of the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization, situated in no-man's land in Jerusalem.

Upon instructions from my Government and in accordance with Security Council resolutions 252 (1968) and 267 (1969), I will be grateful if a report on this new Israeli violation is issued, as urgently as possible, as an official document of the Security Council.

May I request that this letter be also circulated as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly.
