Administrative and financial implications of the decision  
of the Special International Conference of United Nations  
Industrial Development Organization

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance  
with rule 15<sup>4</sup> of the rules of procedure of the General  
Assembly

1. In paragraph 3 of the prefatory note to the report of the Special International Conference of UNIDO<sup>1/</sup> it was indicated that the Conference had authorized the Rapporteur to prepare, in consultation with the geographical groups, a consolidated record containing the summary records of the Conference and the recorded statements of delegations made during the general debate. The costs of translation, typing, reproduction and distribution of approximately 550 pages of the record is estimated at \$80,000.
2. Accordingly, should the General Assembly approve of the proposal of the Conference an additional \$80,000 would be required in the budget for 1972.
