The Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Government of the Republic of Ghana:

Desirous of promoting mutual understanding and strengthening the friendship and cooperation between the two countries;

Guided by the principles and purposes enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law, particularly respect for and promotion of international peace and security, State sovereignty, equality among States, independence, international treaties, territorial integrity, and non-interference in the internal affairs of other States;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18th April 1961, as of the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué;

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in English language.
