Draft report of Secretary-General on the various provisions of this resolution prepared by UNEP for submission to the General Assembly at its forty-sixth session through ECOSOC. The report will also be submitted to the Preparatory Committee for the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development as part of an overall report on desertification including also an assessment of the status of desertification and the implementation of the Plan of Action to Combat Desertification.
