ANNEX

Statement on Liberia, issued on 27 September 1991 at
Brussels and The Hague by the European Community

The Community and its member States welcome the final communiqué of the second meeting of the Committee of Five of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), held at Yamassoukro on 16 and 17 September. They have noted with satisfaction the agreement of the parties involved on disarmament and on the organization and supervision of free and democratic elections. They express the hope that the steps agreed by the parties attending the meeting will be immediately and successfully implemented.

The Community and its member States remain deeply concerned about the humanitarian needs of the Liberian people and hope that a peaceful solution of the conflict will bring a rapid end to their sufferings and open the possibility to build a democratic Liberia.
