NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND FAMILY

3 NOVEMBER 1952 - Royal Order amending the Royal Order of 31 December 1930 concerning the traffic in soporific and narcotic substances.

Article 1. The following additions shall be made to the list contained in article 1 of the Royal Order of 31 December 1930, as amended by article 1 of the Royal Order of 20 September 1951:

"(8 bis) 3 hydroxy - N methylmorphinane and its salts;

"(13 bis) 1 methyl - 3 ethyl - 4 phenyl, 4 propionoxypiperidine and its salts;".

Article 2. The following addition shall be made to the list contained in article 1 bis, paragraph 1, of the Royal Order of 31 December 1930, as amended by the Royal Order of 20 September 1951:

"(2 bis) morpholinylethylmorphine and its salts;".

Article 3. The Minister of Public Health and the Family shall be responsible for the enforcement of this Order.
