LAWS AND REGULATIONS

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1931 FOR LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

The Congress has approved, in virtue of the Federal Constitution, Article 56, paragraph 1, and 1 do hereby promulgate the following:

LEGISLATIVE DECREE
No. 7 of 1959

To approve the Protocol for Limiting and Regulating the Cultivation of the Poppy Plant, the Production of, International and Wholesale

Trade in, and Use of Opium

Article l

The Protocol for Limiting and Regulating the Cultivation of the Poppy Plant, the Production of, International and Wholesale Trade in, and Use of Opium, signed in New York on 23 June 1953 at the United Nations Opium Conference, is hereby approved.

Article 2

This legislative decree shall enter into force on the date of its publication, and all provisions of law conflicting therewith are hereby repealed.
