Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of the United Kingdom.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER
THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1937

(No. 10 of 1937)

UNDER SECTION 10 (3) OF THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1937,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Part IV of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1937, shall apply to the drugs specified in the Schedule hereto in the same manner as it applies to the drugs mentioned in subsection (1) of section 10 of the said Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

Amidone (dl-2-dimethylamino-4: 4-diphenylheptane-5-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of amidone.

Dihydrodesoxymorphine (commonly known as desomorphine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrodesoxymorphine.

Methyldihydromorphinone (commonly known as Metopon), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methyldihydromorphinone.

Pethidine (1 methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of pethidine.

Any preparation, not being a preparation capable of external use only, made from extract or tincture of Indian hemp.
