## LAWS AND REGULATIONS

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1931 FOR LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

### BURMA

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

#### THE OPIUM (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1958

ACT No. XIII OF 1958

It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. This Act may be called the Opium (Amendment) Act, 1958.

2. In the Opium Act, Part I, after section 12 thereof, the following shall be inserted as section 12A; namely:

"12A. The Magistrate may direct in any case in which he has ordered the confiscation under this Part, of motor vehicles, vessels and other motor conveyances which have been used for the commission of an offence against this Part, that such motor vehicles, vessels and motor conveyances shall, notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, be forfeited to Government and be disposed of in such manner as may be prescribed by rules made in this behalf."
