BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

Short title.

- 19. 4,4-diphenyl-6-morpholinoheptanone-3 or 6-morpholino-4,4-diphenyl-3-heptanone and its salts (PHENADOX ONE, CB-11, Hepagin, Heptalgin, Heptalin, Heptazone).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Poisons, Opium, and Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Act. No. 42 of 1953.

Short title.

2. Section 75 of the Poisons, Opium, and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:-

Amendment of section 75 of Chapter 172

- (1) in sub-section (2) of that section by the substitution, for the words "rank of inspector has", of the words "rank of inspector or any officer of the Excise Striking Force not below the rank of Preventive Officer has";
- (2) in sub-section (3) of that section by the substitution, for the words "or excise officer may", of the words "excise officer, or officer of the Excise Striking Force may".
