### NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

Notice placing substances under the Opium Act

In pursuance of article 4, first paragraph, of Act no. 53 of 6 March 1936 on the manufacture of and trade in opium (cf. Act no. 495 of 14 December 1948), the Ministry of Home Affairs and of Housing hereby provides that as from 1 September 1953, the following substances shall be placed under the said Act:

*Morphine group*

Acetyldihydrocodeine

$\beta$ -4-morpholinylethylmorphine

Desomorphine = Permonid (R)<sup>1/</sup> = 6.7-dihydro-5-desoxymorphine ✓

Diacetyl-dihydromorphine = Paralaudin (R)

Dihydrocodeine = Paracodine (R)

Dihydromorphine = Paramorfan (R)

Metopon = 6-methyldihydromorphinone

Nalorphine (INN)<sup>2/</sup> = Nalline (R) = N-allylnormorphine = N-allyl-N-desmethyl-morphine

Methorphan (NNR)<sup>3/</sup> (BAN)<sup>4/</sup> = 3-hydroxy-N-methyl-morphinan

[Racemorphan (INN) = DL-compound

Levorphan (INN) = L-compound

Dextrorphan (INN) = D-compound]

3-methoxy-N-methyl-morphinan

[Dextromethorphan (INN) = D-compound

Levomethorphan (INN) = L-compound

Racemethorphan (INN) = DL-compound]

Alphameprodine (NFN)<sup>5/</sup>, (INN) =  $\alpha$ -1-methyl-3-ethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyloxy piperidine

Alphaprodine (NFN, INN) = Prisiliden (R) = DL- $\alpha$ -1.3-dimethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyloxy piperidine

Bemidone = Hydroxypethidine = 1-methyl-4-(3-hydroxyphenyl)-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester

Betameprodine (NFN, INN) =  $\beta$ -1-methyl-3-ethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyloxy-piperidine

Betaprodine (BAN) =  $\beta$ -1.3-dimethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyloxy piperidine

Ketobemidone (NFN) = Cetobemidon (INN) = Cliradon (R) = 1-methyl-4-(3-hydroxyphenyl)-piperidine-4-ethylketone

Pethidine (NFN, INN) = Dolantin (R) = 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-carboxylic acid ethyl ester

*Methadone group*

Isomethadone (NFN, INN) = L-6-dimethylamino-5-methyl-4.4-diphenyl-3-hexanone  
Methadol (BAN) = 6-dimethylamino-4.4-diphenyl-3-heptanol  
Methadone (NFN, INN) = Butalgin (R) = Polamidon (R) = DL-6-dimethylamino-4.4-diphenyl-3-heptanone  
Methadyl acetate (BAN) = 6-dimethylamino-4.4-diphenyl-3-acetoxyheptane  
Phanadoxone (NFN, INN) = Heptalgin (R) = 6-morpholino-4.4-diphenyl-3-heptanone

*Di thienylbutylamines*

3-dimethylamino-1.1-di-(2-thienyl)-1-buten  
3-ethylmethylamino-1.1-di-(2-thienyl)-1-buten

The same shall apply to salts of these substances and to solutions, dilutions and preparations containing or manufactured from these substances.

Order No. 94 of the Ministry of Home Affairs and of Housing, of 19 March 1952, placing substance under the aforesaid Act shall be repealed as from 1 September 1953.
