Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of Egypt.

MINISTER OF HEALTH

Order amending list of narcotic substances

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH,

In view of Article 32 of Law No. 21 of 1928 governing traffic in and the use of narcotic substances;

ORDERS:

Article 1.- The following substances are added to the list of narcotic substances referred to in the aforementioned law:

- (a) Hydrochloride of methyldihydromorphinone (known as Metopon Hydrochloride or under different names);
- (b) d1-2-dimethylamino 4: 4-diphenylheptane-5-one (known under the names of amidone, physeptone, miadone, dolophine, methadone, adanon, diaminon or other names).

Article 2.- This order shall come into force two months after publication in the Official Journal.
