Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of Egypt.

In view of the proposal submitted by the Under-Secretary of State, Ministry of Interior for P.S. Affairs -

DECIDED the following:

Firstly- An Administration to combat narcotic drugs to be established in the Ministry of Interior and attached to the P.S.D. under the name of "Anti-Narcotics Administration".

Secondly- This Administration to be in charge of a director assisted by a sub-director and both to be police officers.

Thirdly- This Administration to comprise branches headed by officers.

The present branches to continue to carry on their work with the understanding that new branches can be established and that their localities can be changed according to exigencies of the service in the future.

Fourthly- Officers, NCO's, policemen and civilian officials now delegated for duties pertaining to the combatting of narcotic drugs to remain delegated until the necessary posts for this Administration are embodied in the budget of the State.

Fifthly-

Sixthly- The Under-Secretary of State of the Ministry of Interior for P.S.A. to draw up the necessary instructions of the good running of the work in this Administration.
